As you may have heard, this year we are adding a very special “category” to our Annual Tricky Tray. Along with the help of Mrs. Sopira and Mrs. Crowell each class will be creating a piece of Art Work to be raffled off on April 9, 2010 at our Tricky Tray.

Over the past couple of months your children have been working on recreating a famous color study painting, *Squares with Concentric Rings*, painted by Russian artist Wassily Kandinsky. Mrs. Sopira introduced the lesson to the children discussing various color combinations used in the painting. Each child was given a painted square on the canvas and was asked, using acrylic paint, to paint circles of color while paying careful attention to complimentary, neutral, and warm and cool colors. Each series of circles within the squares is unique. This study encouraged the students to become aware of infinite color groupings. The outcome, as you can see, is amazing!

The finished framed piece now hangs in the school’s main hallway. Please stop in and see what a fantastic masterpiece your children created.
